Over the two-day conference, Leading professionals from the industry and academia around the world deliberated on global management techniques to speed up growth by boosting competency. Mr Jonas Brunschwig, Consul General of Switzerland and Dr Philip G Laird, Vice President Innovation, Global Academic Partnerships, Trinity Western University, Canada inaugurated conference. Rev.
